Georgia Tech Office of Institutional Research and Planning (IRP) supports other departments, including research, decision-making support, institutional planning support, and data literacy training. This support also takes the form of both comparative and strategic analysis.

Institutional Research



IRP leverages institutional and external data to provide analysis, benchmarking, and decision support that supports strategic planning, academic program review, ad hoc request fulfillment, and continuous institutional improvement.

Decision-Making Support



IRP equips leadership with trusted, official data through analyses, benchmarking, dashboards, and standard or tailored reports for informed decision support. We respond to data requests with actionable insights for academic and operational decisions.

Data Literacy Consultation



IRP builds campus stakeholder data literacy through one-on-one consultation, team meetings, conferences, and workshops. The office provides ongoing informal education and data support to help stakeholders understand data and reporting expectations.

Institutional Planning



IRP informs long-term planning by delivering accurate data for academic and administrative initiatives. The unit supplies data for accreditation and support budget projections by providing enrollment and credit hour data for resource allocation.

Strategic Analysis



IRP identifies key trends and provides enrollment projections that other units use for future planning. We conduct responsive, question-driven strategic analysis and benchmarking studies aligned with institutional priorities.
